EBay on iPhone is remarkable so it doesn't include as much as what it includes. The best use of eBay on iPhone is to keep an eye on bids for things you're selling, or to quickly bid on an item when you're off the computer. You can browse categories such as Antiques, Boats, Clothing & Accessories, Computers & Networks, Jewelry & Watches & Video Games. When you see something you like, click the auction title and you'll see details, including images, descriptions, payment options, and shipping information. If you have a pretty good idea of what you're looking for, you can search for it using simple keywords, such as Apple iPod, or using more advanced search criteria that help narrow results, such as exclude keywords, item location, price range, and accepted payment methods. If you bid on an item, you enter a contractual agreement to purchase it if you win the auction. All auctions have minimum initial bids and some have a reserve price: a secret minimum amount that the seller is willing to accept for the item. If the bid does not reach the booking price, the seller does not have to separate from the item. In addition to auctions, you can find tons of fixed price items on eBay that make shopping there just like shopping in any other online marketplace. You see what you like, you buy it, you pay for it and you wait for it to come to your door. There are also auction announcements that give you the option to Buy Now for a price that is usually higher than the start price of the auction. If you choose to buy the item for the price now instead of bidding on it, the auction ends instantly and the item is yours. You can pay for an item on eBay using a variety of methods, including money order, cash check, cash, personal check and electronic electronics such as PayPal and BidPay. It is up to each seller to decide which payment methods they will accept. PayPal is the easiest way to buy something on eBay, as eBay owns PayPal.
